Begg gets win in West Coast Bowl

Santa Margarita defensive end Nick Begg yearned for conditioning.

After having just two days to prepare, he wasn't properly equipped to handle the uptempo offense he had to face in the South Bay BMW West Coast Bowl on Sunday at Home Depot Center put on by B2G Sports. Once the fourth quarter rolled around, Begg was gassed.

"We were getting so tired from their offense," Begg said. "They were just running all over us."

Begg couldn't afford to succumb to fatigue. His Red Team was on the ropes after surrendering 13 consecutive points and watching their 21-3 lead dwindle away. Up by just five points, they needed to keep the Green Team from getting into the endzone.

It's a good thing he had one more play left in the tank. With 12 seconds remaining, the Green Team was driving inside Red territory when quarterback Jared Lebowitz dropped back to pass. The pocket quickly collapsed and Begg provided what proved to be the game winning sack to secure a 21-16 win for the Red Team. Out of timeouts, the Green Team was unable to run another play.

"It was a great way to go out of high school," Begg said. "(That's) my favorite play of (my) high school career. A great way to end it."

The Red Team seemed to be in full command when Citrus Valley quarterback Dalton Douglas found Santa Margarita's River Cracraft on touchdown over the middle to put the Red Team up 21-3 in the third quarter.

But the Green Team showed some fight. Running an uptempo no-huddle spread offense brought by Narbonne head coach Manuel Douglas, the Green Team had a tough time completing passes in the first half.

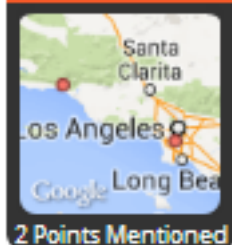
